

# Rules of the 2005 International AMV Contest

## Article 1 : Organizer

Organizes an AMV contest ; the deadline is 05th August 2005

## Article 2 : Entrants

The contest is open to all, except to professional video makers, staff from the contest, and members of the jury.

## Article 3 : Object

Making an anime music video for the Fantasy Movies french annual contest.

This year event will take place at the Japanim Spirit 6 con.

Entrants are free to choose video(s) footage(s), but the AMV must use predominantly anime footage.

## Article 4 : Rules registration

The contest registration can be individual or grouped, but just one participation by person/group will be accepted.

Entrants must give:

- The music video in \*.avi (DivX, Xvid), mpeg1, mpeg2 or wmv.

- The registration form completed

The deadline to send the music video is the 05th August 2005.

Entrants can also send their music video on our ftp server and must ask an access by mail to amvcontest@fantasy-movies.net.

For mail entries, we can accept DVD and CD as supports.

Accepted formats are: DivX, XviD, mpeg, mpeg2 and wmv.

Every video sent after the deadline will not be accepted.

Every submission without all informations needed won't be accepted.

Your participation to this contest implies the entire acceptation of these rules.

## Article 5 : guarantees

Every entrant (single or group) who's submitting his work to this contest attests and guarantees that he's its only and exclusive author and that he doesn't transgress directly or indirectly any right of a third.

Every entrant of the contest accepts, to see his project exposed and showed on the websites, and screened during the events organized by Japan Expo, Japanim Spirit, Yatta.tv or Fantasy Movies.

Every use of an existing work is disqualifying, same goes for works including slanderous, racist or pornographic features, or that may attack the physic or moral integrity of anyone.

## Article 6 : Jury

The members of the jury will be chosen by the organizers of the contest.

It will be composed of AMV makers, and professionals and amateurs from the domain of animation.

## Article 7 : Selection standards

Selection standards will be as followed:

- Originality/creativity of the work
- Quality and aestheticism of the render
- Encoding quality

## Article 10 : Ranking

This year's rankings will be separated in two categories.

International Ranking : All entrants will be ranked.

French Ranking : Only France resident entrants will be ranked.

## Article 11 : Return of submission support

Submission supports, CDs or DVDs, will not be sent back after the contest.

## Article 12 : Contest Modification or Cancellation

Fantasy Movies reserves itself full liberty to modify the rules of this contest or cancel the contest if necessary. Fantasy Movies responsibility should not be engaged in any of these cases.

## Article 13 : Consent to use your AMVs

All entrants consent to Fantasy Movies, Japan Expo, Japanim Spirit and Yatta.tv the right to use their work freely for screening, showing, and communication. They also accept the use of any picture taken for the occasion as communication material.

## Article 14 : Rules clarification

Any ambiguity about these rules will be submitted to and solved directly by Fantasy Movies.
